We carried 200 Kg of Rice, 150 Kg of Green Grams and 100 Kg of Sugar with us to provide food substances to the needy people.

First, we reached an area named Irulam. There we met Rev. Father Sony who guided us to reach the affected areas. Then we reached Kirupalaya, a special School at Pulpally. The School provides non-formal and vocational education to special children like mentally challenged autistic, ADHD and the physically challenged. It is a day school with 125 special children. The school gives vocational training like book binding, doll making, paper plate making and so on to the poor children.

We handed over food materials to the sisters of that convent. They acknowledged the help extended by our school. Then, we visited some of the Special Children’s Home at other flood affected areas like Manandhavadi, Kurumani etc.,

Over all, the trip gave us more satisfaction as we were able to help the brothers and sisters of the State of Kerala.
